IED SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

In the framework of the Under 35 category at INVIDEO 2014, the Milan Istituto Europeo di Design is offering a scholarship covering the complete cost of tuition for its three-year course in **Video Design**, which is held in Italian, starting from October 2014. The winner will still have to cover the cost of the registration fee and regional taxes (info: **www.ied.it**). To maintain scholarship entitlement for all over the three years of the course, the winning student must keep up an average score of 28/30 marks and be up to date with administrative responsibilities (sums due must be paid within the deadlines specified by the school).

INVIDEO/IED AWARD REGULATION

1. Entry requirements:

- No registration fee required;
- Anybody (Italian or foreign), aged from 18 to 28 years not yet turned on 21
 March 2013, may take part;
- The works must have the following features:
 - 1.produced in the last three years (2012-2014);
 - 2. genre: video art, experimental documentaries and animation, video research, dance video, theatre video, music video, abstract videos, portrait videos, portraits of cities etc., **no fiction**;
 - 3. maximum length 5 minutes;
 - 4. be in DVD format of a high enough quality for projection.
- Each videomaker can enter an unlimited number of works. Every work must be accompanied by fully completed call for competition entry form and by the required materials.
- DVD preview copies won't be sent back, they'll be kept in INVIDEO office for study purposes.
- DVD preview copies must be sent without charge for INVIDEO and/or IED. They must be accompanied by fully completed call for competition entry form and by the following documentation: synopsis, technical data sheet, videomaker's bio-filmography and/or c.v. (including place and date of birth), CD with three or more stills of the video in jpg format/300 dpi.
- All these materials must be received by March 21st 2013 at the following address:

2. Selection:

- All the works correctly sent by the deadline will be judged by a Selection Committee of experts according to contents, and to artistic and aesthetic principles, which won't be brought into question.
 The selection committee reserves the right to evaluate each work and is not obliged to explain the selection criteria to not selected authors. Finally the selection committee reserves the right to not assign prizes if if there are no works eligible regarding the features or the quality.

- The selected works will be screened in their original language.
